To our staff and community members of Fleetwood-Bawden Elementary School,

Fleetwood-Bawden Elementary School has recently been notified by Alberta Health Services that they have identified one case of COVID-19 at the school.

AHS Public Health is responsible for contact tracing - identifying and notifying all who have had close contact with the case. Public Health and the school will work closely together to ensure timely and accurate contact tracing. Close contacts will be called and instructed to quarantine for at least 14 days. Public Health also has provided recommendations to the school about cleaning measures and other control measures to reduce the risk of further transmission. If you are not contacted, then your child is not a close contact and can attend school as usual following all public health guidance.

Our thoughts remain with this individual that has tested positive, and their family. We wish them a safe and speedy recovery.

The school schedule will proceed as normal for Monday, Oct. 19, 2020.

Out of respect to this individual and in accordance with Alberta Health Services guidelines, we cannot disclose personal details.

We remind our staff team to monitor for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 using the [Alberta Health Screening Questionnaire](#). Please remember to complete the checklist each day prior to attending school. If you or a member of your family has any of the symptoms of illness listed, please fill out the online [Alberta Health Services COVID-19 self-assessment](#) or call Health Link at 811.

Out of an abundance of caution and as we continue our focus on preventing the spread of COVID-19, we have directed our custodial services team to conduct enhanced cleaning. This additional cleaning will focus on areas where the individual was present along with high touch areas and surfaces throughout the facility.

The health and safety of our staff, students, and community is paramount. We know this news can be distressing and supports are available.

Please rest assured we will continue to work closely with Alberta Health Services and the Medical Officer of Health in the South Zone to ensure we follow their ongoing recommendations.
