Dear parents/guardians/students,

We have been notified by Alberta Health Services (AHS) that a case of COVID-19 has been diagnosed in an individual from Joane Cardinal-Schubert High School.

Our school remains open to in-person learning for all students, and we are working closely with AHS to ensure necessary measures continue to be in place to protect all students and staff. This includes cleaning and disinfecting all items touched by the individual, and removing and storing items that cannot be cleaned and disinfected (paper, books, etc.) in a sealed container for a minimum of 72 hours.

Our Facilities staff will also have completed extended disinfecting of key spaces prior to school opening tomorrow.

We know parents have many questions about who the individual might be, but it is important that we respect the confidentiality of the individual. AHS will be contacting only those parents/guardians of students, as well as any staff/visitors/volunteers who may have been in close contact with the individual who has tested positive.

All students directed to quarantine by AHS will be supported by the school in maintaining course work during the designated period through D2L. They will not join Hub online learning.

We remind parents/guardians of students, as well as any staff/visitors/volunteers to monitor for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19. The Alberta Health daily checklist can be found [here](#). Please remember to complete the checklist each day prior to attending school.
